WE DEMAND THE GOVERNMENT:

- 1) Pass legislation like Assembly Bill #A09270 to:
 - Prohibit mandatory overtime so we can say NO to long hours
 - Require Workers Comp cases be resolved within 3 months
 - Give interim Workers Comp benefits 1 week after applying
 - Raise the minimum benefit rates for Workers' Comp
- 2) Expand Family Health Plus income eligibility guidelines so all NY workers can enjoy health care
- 3) Pay reparations for lying to all workers injured by 9/11 toxic air, including establishing a medical institution to deal with health problems related to toxic air
